Tuesday 7th July: World Chocolate Day: The children will take part in some baking activities and will bake our delicious chocolate and beetroot brownies.


Saturday 11th July: World Population Day: Children in the preschool room will be learning about the world's population.

MOST RECENT DATA ANALYSIS JUNE 2020 The main outcomes were:

- 93.5% of all children are achieving age related expectations and above in all areas of Mathematics.
- 91.5% of all children are achieving age related expectations and above in all areas of Physical development.
- 100% of girls are achieving age related expectations and above in all areas of listening and attention and understanding.
- 100% of boys are achieving age related expectations and above in all areas of writing.

We are very proud of our achievements in the prime areas of learning as we are exceeding local and national averages.
