September sees the introduction of the revised EYFS. Our staff team have been accessing monthly training since January of this year in preparation for this. One of the main aims of the revisions is to remove the need for extensive data gathering so that our staff have more time to teach your children. We are working on getting more information out to you in September, as we get used to using the revised framework. You may notice slight differences in the way in which observations on Family look but the way in which we are teaching your children will not change. As part of these revisions we have designed our own ambitious curriculum which will be made available to you soon. This will detail what children will learn whilst they are with us.
