#### Reminders

\*If your child has recently turned 3, they may be eligible for 30 hours funding from January. Visit <a href="https://www.childcarechoices.gov.uk/">https://www.childcarechoices.gov.uk/</a> for more information & to see if you are eligible. Please also remember that it is important to renew your code if you are already receiving funding. If you are not eligible for 30 hours, your child will still receive 15 hours funding.

#### Other Information

#### \*Acknowledgement of accident/medication forms-

Could all parents please ensure they are acknowledging the accident and medication form son famly please. You will receive a notification if any forms are written up for your child.

- \* Extra sessions Please be aware that when booking any extra/additional sessions for your child/ren, they must be paid for in advance of the session. We will be posting what availability we have for the new few weeks.
- \* Late collection Please be aware that morning sessions finish at 1pm and afternoon/ full day sessions finish by 6pm. Please ensure you are collecting your children on time, or you may be likely to incur a late collection charge.
- \*Accident & Medication- Please can you continue to ensure that you are reporting any accidents that occur before nursery or if your child has had any medication prior to nursery. It is important that we are recording this information. Feel free to message us this information on famly if you feel you may forget to inform staff during handover.

We are doing medication forms electronically on our Family app, if you could inform staff if your child has had any medication before nursery/ requires medication during nursery hours then we can get the relevant forms completed for you to acknowledge on family.

\* Child's sickness/days off- Please can we remind all parents to report their child's absence using the family app. This helps the staff us with monitoring children's attendance in nursery and also helps with collecting children from afterschool ensuring there are no missed communications. If your child has not been marked off, we will collect you child from school and bring them back to the allocated site. (Gilmour Garston site, Springwood bridge chapel site.)
